

Configuring Eclipse to use the SWT Libraries and Running an SWT-based Application:

- Download the .zip of SWT 3.1 for your platform
For Windows, you should download a zip file named "swt-3.1-win32-win32-x86.zip" by visiting <http://www.eclipse.org/downloads/download.php?file=/eclipse/downloads/drops/R-3.1-200506271435/swt-3.1-win32-win32-x86.zip> and choosing a mirror (e.g. [Israel] [NSA Internet & Security Ltd.](#)). For other platforms go to <http://download.eclipse.org/eclipse/downloads/drops/R-3.1-200506271435/index.php>
- Follow the instructions in <http://www.eclipse.org/swt/eclipse.php>
Note: To open the properties dialog of your Java project, click right click on you project in the package explorer view.
